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Grading Policy



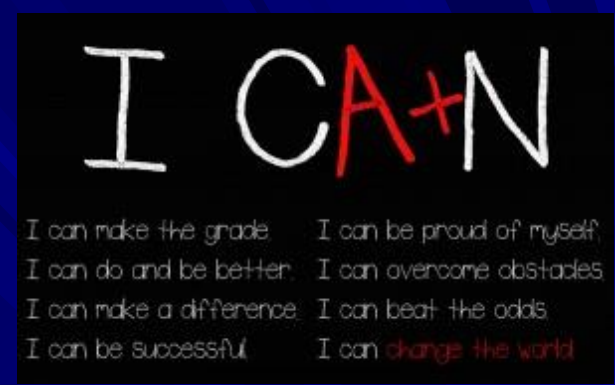
- 90%-100% **A**, 80%-89% **B**, 70-79% **C**, 60-69% **D**, below 60% **F**
- Grades will be weighted and consist of the following categories:
 - **Tests** 45%
 - **Quizzes** 30%
 - **Class Work** 15%
 - (Warm-ups, Projects, Group Work, White Board, Worksheets)
 - **Homework** 10%
 - (Students will show all work and correct daily)
- A student's effort grade is determined by averaging their classwork and homework. Citizenship is determined by a student's classroom behavior and tardies.

Policies Cont...

- Late homework can be turned in for half credit up the test date it belongs to.
- Assessment Retakes: One retake per assessment can be done, an assessment correction is a students “ticket” to retake. A retake must be completed before a grading period ends.



Tools to Succeed



- I am available during “help” times and there are many “help” clubs students can take advantage of.
- Parents and students should check **Aeries** for missing assignments, grades, and report cards.
- Students should write down homework and upcoming assessment dates. They should stay on top of their assignments, study, and always makeup absent and missed work. Good attendance is very important.
