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## Grading Policy

$>$ Grades will be weighted and consist of the following categories:
$\checkmark$ Assessments (Tests \& Quizzes) 50\%
- Performance Tasks 20\%
- Class Work 20\%
(Warmups, Projects, Group Work, White Board, Worksheets)
- Homework 10\%
- (Students will show all work and correct daily)
$>$ A students effort grade is determined by averaging their classwork and homework. Citizenship is determined by a students classroom behavior and tardies.


## Retakes \& Late Work



- Assessment Retakes: One retake per assessment can be done.
$>$ An assessment correction is a students "ticket" to retake. A retake must be completed before a grading period ends.
$>$ Late homework can be turned in for half credit up the test date it belongs to.
